DAY OF PRAYER AND PENANCE FOR VICTIMS OF SEXUAL ABUSE:

At the May 2017 Plenary, the Australian Catholic Bishops discussed the report of the Royal Commission into Institutional responses to Child Sexual Abuse. The bishops considered the 'Day of Prayer and Penance' proposed by the Holy Father Pope Francis and progressed by the Secretary of State Cardinal Pietro Parolin in his letter to the Bishop's Conference in June 2016. The bishops agreed that the day will be marked on Child Protection Sunday, held on the second Sunday of September each year. This coincides with the culmination of the National Child Protection Week from 3rd-9th September.

CHILD PROTECTION SUNDAY 10th September "See Me, Hear Me

In 2016, following a proposal from the Pontifical Commission for the Protection of Minors, the Holy Father established a 'Day of prayer and penance for the victims of sexual abuse and to ask God for a greater awareness of the responsibility of the members of the Church towards the underaged people entrusted to them.' Here in Australia, this second-stated purpose is already the focus of Child Protection Sunday, which is observed each year on the second Sunday in September.
