Parish Finance Committee Annual Report

Dear Parishioners

We have now completed 12 months of the 'new' planned giving program and on behalf of the parish's finance committee we are happy to report that there has been a substantial increase in giving from the previous program.

Contributions are currently \$3868.88 per week up from \$2822.32 per week twelve months ago. The total giving amount for the twelve-month period of the new program equates to 94.27% of the total pledged amount, by comparison to 82.50% at the time the old program ended. This has led to a more positive outlook with regard the parish's overall financial position. As reported at the time the planned giving renewal program was held last year, the parish had run at a loss in the previous two financial periods.

Unfortunately, we reported a further loss in the 2017/18 financial year ending 31st March 2018 in the amount of \$28,224.41. This was due, in part, to the cost of running the planned giving renewal program, building, equipment & maintenance costs. At the same time Diocesan levies totalled \$25,000 while insurance premiums reached \$35,980. The good news is that our 2018/19 forecast is for a surplus (the first time in three years). This on the back of the increase in planned giving revenue and greater returns from invested monies...the two primary sources of our parish income.

Funds gained in recent times from the sale of properties such as St Mary's Hall and the Pearson Street residence have been invested in longer term investment options with Catholic Church Insurance Asset Management. In this regard we have budgeted for additional interest income this financial year of \$27,000 from these investments.

Included in this year's budget is money for more building maintenance work and includes the Rosedale church, where the tiled roof will be cleaned, and roof flashing and cracked walls repaired, and replacement heaters for the Stratford church.

Our current financial reports show that the parish is in a healthier financial position than we were twelve months ago. As Planned Giving income accounts for 70% of our total revenue it is vital that the program is maintained at its current level of 94% of the pledge at least to cover the increasing costs of running the parish. So, we thank you all for your support of the program and your making of regular contributions.

The finance committee would be very grateful if those of our parishioners who may have fallen behind with their pledge could recommence. If there is anyone who is not part of the program and who would like to join please contact the parish office.

You may consider electronic giving. Electronic giving is a convenient way for you to give regularly to our Planned Giving Program and support the ongoing works of our parish community. By giving electronically, the parish is guaranteed your gift on a regular basis and budgeting becomes more accurate. It also is much safer for the parish as there is less cash to handle and it reduces the work of voluntary counters. Electronic giving is flexible and can be changed or cancelled at any time as necessary. Direct Debit Request authority forms are available from the foyer of any of our churches or from the parish office. Payment can be made from a credit card or bank, building society or credit union account and can be made on a weekly, fortnightly, monthly, quarterly or yearly basis.

Thank you for your generous and ongoing support to our parish.
