OUR NEW WAY OF BEING ST MARY'S CATHEDRAL PARISH

Parish life is very different now, and changing all the time.

- At this time we are able to offer Mass for up to **20 parishioners** only. **All Cathedral Mass attendance must still be booked on 5144 4100 or by ringing the Priests. For other Church bookings please ring Loch Sport - Madeline Evans, Stratford - Beth Kilpatrick, Briagolong - Margaret Anderson and Rosedale - Veronica Barnes.**
- The Parish office remains closed. Clare is in the Office on Monday's and Friday's as she is unable to work from home. Contact with the office should be via email to sale@cdsale.org.au or by phoning **5144 4100**.
- Only Parishioners who have booked to attend Mass may attend. **Please do not 'just turn up'** as you may be offended should you be turned away.

- At all Masses, at least one parishioner is requested to please act as an 'usher'. The role of the usher is to check those in attendance, to remind people to use the hand sanitiser, to direct parishioners to their seats, to maintain social distancing at all times, and to remind parishioners that the Church and toilet area must be disinfected and cleaned after every gathering. The usher will have a checklist to work from.
- We are only able to offer Mass provided we fully meet the regulations set out by the Government and the Diocese. **Failure to faithfully meet these requirements can result in substantial fines and possibly the closing of our Churches.**

But we believe that having died with Christ we shall return to life with him: Christ, as we know, having been raised from the dead will never die again. Death has no power over him any more. When he died, he died, once for all, to sin, so his life now is life with God; and in that way, you too must consider yourselves to be dead to sin but alive for God in Christ Jesus.
